

Wanhuida Partner speaks at CTA Session during INTAAM

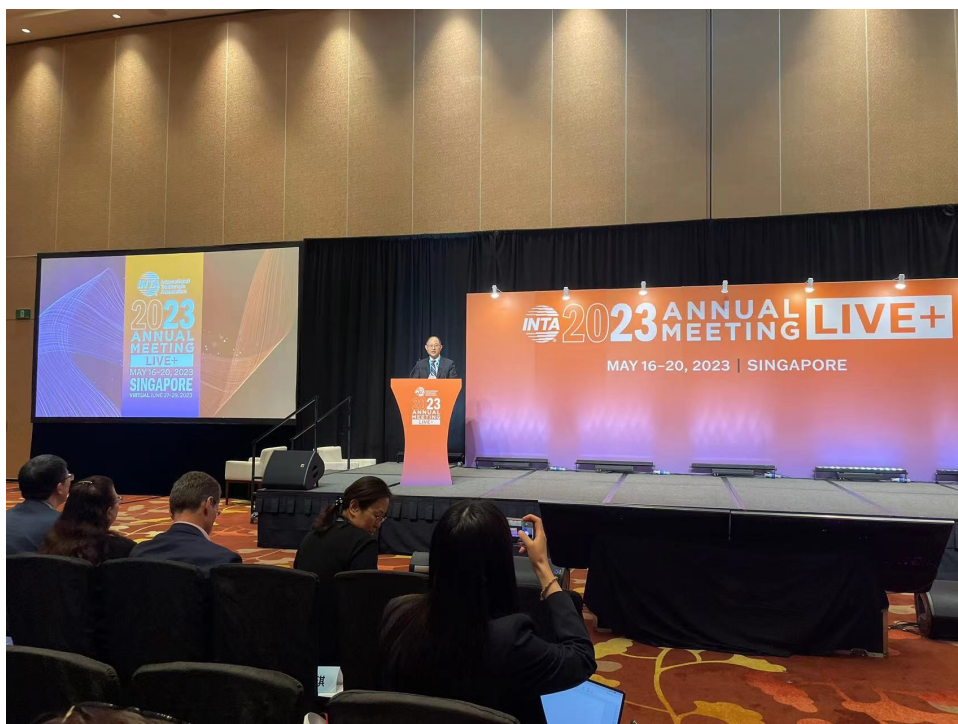

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On Thursday May 18th, 2023, an INTA IP and Innovation track, featuring “An Up-to-Date Review of Trademark Law and Practice in China”, is held in Singapore at 3:45 pm – 4:45 pm local time.
