His track records also include one case that is selected as the Deals of Year by China Business Law Journal for its significance of being an exception to the Safe Harbor Principle, a criminal proceeding against a sophisticated counterfeiting syndicate that is included in the annual 50 exemplary IP cases by China's Supreme People's Court as well as another one selected as one of the 10 Exemplary IP Cases in 2020 by Xi'an Intermediate Court.
