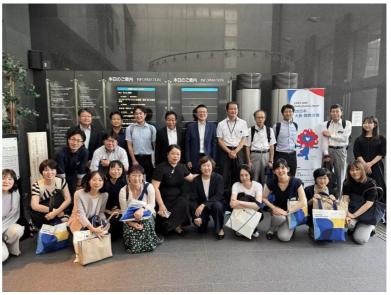
Wanhuida Partner speaks at symposiums and launches new book in Japan

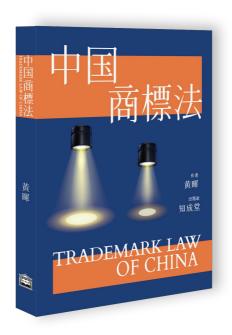
